



Global CBPR Forum Announces the Establishment of the Global CBPR and Global PRP Systems and Welcomes New Global CAPE Participants

April 30, 2024

Celebrating the second anniversary of its establishment, the Global CBPR Forum (Forum) announces the establishment of the Global CBPR and Global PRP Systems with the appointment of Accountability Agents and the publication of the System documents (/documents/). The publication of these documents sets the stage for Accountability Agents to start issuing Global CBPR and Global PRP certifications to interested organizations this summer.

The Forum has approved the following Accountability Agents to operate in these jurisdictions:

The Office of the Privacy Commissioner of Bermuda, the Office of the Commissioner of Data Protection of the Dubai International Financial Center Authority, and the UK Information Commissioner's Office have joined the Global CAPE. Together with PEAs from Canada, Japan, Korea, Mexico, the Philippines, Singapore, Chinese Taipei, and the US, the total number of Global CAPE participants now stands at 27.
